

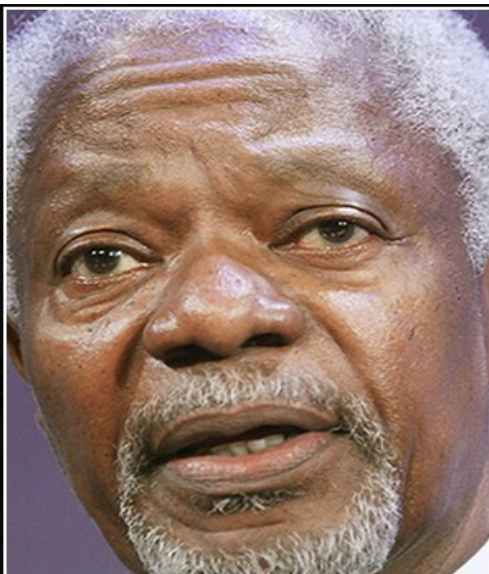

3. Compare the gender ratio of various countries across the globe.
4. Learn to appreciate Human-a gift of God, irrespective of gender.

Guidelines for doing the holiday home work

1. Prepare a folder using recyclable/reusable eco – friendly material and **arrange the sheets of all subjects in the same folder.**
2. Make a neat cover page with your class, section and the theme "**Gender Equality**" written on it.
3. The work should be **hand written only.**
4. Use A4 sized coloured sheets (Ruled/interleaf as required) for doing the same.
5. Maximum of 25 sheets should be used for the entire project.
5. Support your research work with relevant pictures, newspaper articles, graphs, lab reports, maps, website references and your individual findings.
6. The work should be neat, organised and well presented.(Kindly do not use sequins, glitter tapes, beads or decorative ribbons, stickers)
7. Arrange the subjects in the order as given below.

SCIENCE

‘Women – The Pillar of Strength’

Women's empowerment means consolidating the power and strength of the women, giving them all desired exposures, equipping them with all amenities they need for triumphantly surging ahead, thus allowing them to accomplish their goals confidently.

“**Mars Orbital Mission-MOM**” is a perfect example of women empowerment.

- Group 1 (Roll 1-10)

Create a **scrap file** on the important Indian social activists who have worked for women empowerment.

Students can research on activists like Aruna Roy, Medha Patkar, Kiran Bedi etc.

- Group 2 (Roll 11-20)

Make a **collage** on the role of Indian cinema in promoting gender equality.

- Group 3 (Roll 21-30)

Make a **Power Point Presentation** on the commercial advertisements depicting gender equality from 1980-2019. Get a printout of the same in A4 size sheet.

- Group 4 (Roll 31-40)

Make a scroll on the Indian laws/ schemes/ programmes which provide equal opportunities to all the Indian citizens.

October 1950
Founds the Missionaries of Charity order

1960s
Opens centres for people with **leprosy, dysentery, tuberculosis**

1979
Awarded the Nobel Peace Prize

September 5, 1997
Dies in Kolkata

2003
Beatified by Pope John Paul II for helping heal a Bengali woman of cancer (1st *miracle*)

September 4, 2016
Pope Francis declares Mother Teresa a saint

2015
Credited by the Vatican with healing a Brazilian man of brain tumours (2nd *miracle*)
